DID YOU KNOW

Did you know that you can make your own liquid drain cleaner using baking soda and vinegar? Well you can. These inexpensive natural products may take a little longer to work, however it works just as well for half of the price as store bought cleaners. Step 1) Pour half a box of baking soda down the drain. Step 2) Pour vinegar over the top of the baking soda to create foaming action. Allow the foam to settle for five minutes or for maximum effect allow the drain to sit unused for 30-60 mins. Step 3) Rinse with hot water to help clear the drain.

BANANA BREAD RECIPE

Ingredients

2 cups all-purpose flour, 1 teaspoon baking powder, 1 teaspoon baking soda, 1 teaspoon salt, 3 ripe mashed bananas, 1 teaspoon milk, 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon (or to taste), ½ cup soften butter, 1 cup white sugar, 2 eggs, 1 cup semisweet chocolate chips.

Directions

1) Preheat oven to 325 degrees F (165 degrees C). 2) Grease a 9x5-inch loaf pan. 3) Mix flour, baking powder, baking soda, and salt in a bowl. 4) Mix in bananas, milk, and cinnamon in another bowl. 5) Beat butter and sugar in a third bowl until light and fluffy then add eggs to butter mixture, one at a time, beating well after each addition. 6) Stir in banana mixture into butter mixture. 7) Then stir in dry mixture until blended. 8) Fold in chocolate chips until combined. 9) Pour batter into loaf pan and bake for 70 minutes. When cooking time is up, stick a toothpick in the center of the loaf. If the toothpick is clean that means your loaf is ready to cool off for 10 minutes before you cut into it.
